

A-Level and Pre-U Results 2017

At A-Level and Pre-U in 2017, our students achieved the third best results in the history of the school. This was a remarkable achievement given that this was the first year of assessment in the new, more demanding, linear A-Levels and a number of subjects had made the switch to taking the Pre-U qualification. 70% of grades were either A*/A (at A-Level) or D1, D2, D3 or M1 (at Pre-U) and 91% of grades were either A*, A or B (at A-Level) or D1, D2, D3, M1 or M2 (at Pre-U). Of the 146 pupils, 58 students achieved nothing lower than an A or D3 grade and 9 students achieved all A* or D1 or D2 grades. In Drama, Greek, Further Mathematics and Music, no student scored a grade lower than a B.

We are proud of the diverse range of university and course selections which illustrate our core values of intellectual curiosity, breadth of study and independence of mind. This year's leavers will move on to a variety of top university destinations including Cambridge, Oxford, Durham and LSE and the most popular universities this year for applications were Bristol, Edinburgh, Cambridge and Oxford. All our applicants for Medicine gained places at institutions such as Oxford, Nottingham and UCL. 100% of UCS pupils went on to Higher Education or equivalent and 21 pupils were offered places to study at Oxford or Cambridge. A number of leavers took up courses at U.S. universities which included institutions such as Yale and Duke.

University degree courses ranged from Architecture to Anthropology and from Modern Languages to Materials Science. 38% of our students were admitted to social science courses, 27% have decided to further their study of arts subjects and 26% of students were admitted to STEM courses.
