

## **External Exam Results Summary 2018**

In 2018, our GCSE pupils achieved the highest number of the top grades in the history of the school. The students outperformed the previous year's impressive cohort as 66% of grades awarded to UCS pupils were A\* (or 8/9). Of 122 pupils, 73 were awarded straight A/A\* grades (or 7, 8, 9 grades) and over 20% of the cohort achieved a clean sweep of A\* (or 8 and 9) grades. Nine boys secured straight 9 and A\* grades and 88% of the year group's grades were the equivalent of A\*-A. 100% A\*-A (or 7/8/9) was secured by all students in Greek, Mandarin and Music.

At A-Level and Pre-U in 2018, our students achieved the second highest numbers of the top grades in the history of the school. A wonderful 31% of exams taken at UCS were graded at A\* (or D1 or D2) and 70% of the grades awarded were A\*-A at A-Level or D1, D2, D3 or M1 (at Pre-U). Impressively, 64 pupils achieved nothing below an A grade. What's more, of the 156 pupils, 64 students scooped nothing lower than an A or a D3 grade and 14 pupils achieved A\* grades (or the Pre-U equivalent) in all of their subjects.

This year's leavers will move on to a variety of the UK's top universities, including Cambridge, Oxford, Imperial College and LSE. The most popular destinations for our students this year were Bristol, Edinburgh, Cambridge and Oxford. 21 students achieved places at either Oxford or Cambridge.

The university degree courses which our pupils will study ranged from Architecture to Anthropology and from Modern Languages to Molecular Bioengineering. 31% of pupils were admitted to STEM courses, 40% were admitted to social sciences and 29% were admitted to arts courses. Applicants for medical schools enjoyed another highly successful year with candidates securing places at universities such as Cambridge, Manchester and Leeds.

Each year a number of applicants defer entry to university to pursue extra-curricular interests, work based schemes or travel during a gap year.

We are also a leading school in terms of admissions to overseas universities. Once again, our pupils were highly successful in 2018 with U.S. and Canadian university admissions, with eight students securing places at highly-regarded institutions such as MIT, Columbia, UPenn and McGill.
